18/630	APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE were received from Mr P Stevens, Mr M Doyle and Ms I Macdonald, Rev D Green and Mr J Musker			
18/631	DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – none other than those routinely declared.			
18/632	MINUTES - the Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 8 October 2018 were approved and signed.			
18/633	MATTERS ARISING (18/573.1) Miss Barkham said how lovely the War Memorial looked. She thanked Mr Stapleton for the planting of the surrounding garden. Outcome of Tenders It was noted that two Tenders had been received, Gavin Jones and Four Seasons, and two no quotes. Appendix 1. After discussion it was agreed that Gavin Jones be awarded the Tender for the Churchyard, all the grass cutting and marking out at the Norman Road Playing Fields and the cutting of the Village Green. Four Seasons to be awarded with the hedge cutting at the Norman Road Playing Fields, Macey's Meadow, the Allotments and the Cricket Meadow. All decisions subject to the approval of F&GP.			
18/634	ALLOTMENTS The Assistant Clerk reported that the hedge, Ryarsh Lane side, had been cut and looked very good. The cricket meadow side will be cut on Friday 16 November 2018.			

18/635	MACEY'S MEADOW	SH	
	The Assistant Clerk reported that she had obtained a quote form TMBC for the installation of a dog waste bin to the rear of the pavilion/boundary of Macey's Meadow. Aylesford Parish Council are removing some of their bins so the Parish Council can have a bin free of charge. The cost of installation is £98.00. To be put into the budget for 2019/20.		
	Ms Stacpoole said that the dog waste bin at the entrance to Macey's Meadow opposite Alma Road was very unpleasant during the hot weather. The Assistant Clerk to obtain quotes for moving the bin further into the meadow.

	It was noted that the quarterly play equipment inspection had been carried out. The lower fixing on the cross chain walk and four top fixings on the log walk need replacing. The Assistant Clerk reported that she had obtained a quotation for their replacement for the sum of £400.00 + VAT. It was agreed that this be accepted.		
	It was noted that a quotation had been received for the completion of the fencing, with replacement gate, along the boundary of the children's play area to the playing fields for the sum of £3820.00 + VAT. It was agreed to include this in the budget for 2019/20.

	It was noted that a quotation had been received for additional security measures along the boundary from Age Concern to the barrier at the entrance to the Cricket Meadow, as follows:		√
	To take out and clear existing barriers. To supply and erect approx. 75m of 1.1m high vertical bar railings and a 4.4m wide barrier. Bow top to consist of 18mm diameter bars fitted on 50x50 section posts which are let into the ground and surrounded by concrete. Barrier to be warden style 1.1m high posts to be let into the ground and surrounded by concrete for the sum of £10141.00 + VAT. It was agreed to include this in the budget for 2019/20.

It was agreed to refer this to Full Council with a view to inviting them to the Annual Parish

	The Assistant Clerk said that this has been reported to TMBC and that they are currently experiencing problems with a vehicle. It is off road and awaiting extensive repairs. They are sharing one vehicle with Tunbridge Wells Borough Council. They have managed to hire a vehicle from a neighbouring authority but the working days are yet to be confirmed. The street cleansing vehicle has been instructed to attend the sites and the clear the glass as necessary to ensure the sites are left clean and tidy.			
	Discussion took place regarding the need to have the recycle bins emptied on a regular basis. Miss Barkham said she would speak with TMBC and request a timetable.

	Discussion took place regarding the annual contribution to the VHMC. Members felt that there should be a reduction in the contribution. It was agreed that this be referred to Full Council, as an agenda item, for further discussion.
