53.1	Rotary House			
	ACV - Mrs Dean reported that T&MBC have now confirmed that Rotary House has been registered as an Asset of Community Value – for details of the decision see: https://democracy.tmbc.gov.uk//ieDecisionDetails.aspx?ID=984 Registration as an ACV means that the building is now subject to moratorium provisions. It was noted that the landowner (in this instance KCC) has the right to request a review of the decision, this request must be made within 8 weeks of notification of the decision. Survey - it was agreed that for the time being, not to proceed with the additional estimate of £750 for a survey of the electrics within the building and to proceed with the quote of £1099.50 + VAT as agreed at the extraordinary meeting of 18/1/21.

55.1	Financial position as of Monday 18 th January 2021 A report had been provided to members detailing the financial position of the Council as of Monday 18th January and 21/22 committee budgets. It was noted that committee underspends of £7,485 have been identified		
	It was noted that once safeguarded sums have been taken into account, that the Council has reserves in the region of £57,000.		
	Potential purchase of Rotary House, Norman Road during 21/22 1. From August 2022 the PWLB repayments of £5,233.84 pa on the Macey's Meadow loan (loan number480383) will terminate. 2. If a successful purchase were to be achieved, a transfer of the Parish Council office		
	would save the Council £3550 annual rent. 3. Reports on the building condition and site valuation are not expected to be available until the February Full Council meeting.		
	In view of the above, Councillors agreed that the first repayment of any PWLB loan could be met from general uncommitted reserves which were expected to be approximately £57,000 at 1/4/21. It was noted that £5000 has placed into the F&GP budget for Rotary House.		
55.2	Council Tax Base Notification has been received from T&MBC that the Council Tax Base for West Malling for 2021/22 is 1,138.21 (this being the number of equivalent Band D properties)		
55.3	Committee Budgets Mrs Dean reported that since the last Full Council meeting the following amendments to the F&GP and Planning Committee had been made: F&GP Committee — an additional £300 for IT update and £5000 for Rotary House expenses. Planning Committee — an additional £10,000 for Local Plan EIP These amendments were agreed. Gross Committee Budgets:£139,724.78 Less income £11,370.00 Total Net Committee Budgets: F&GP total budget = £60,580.00 Highways total budget £23,694.00 Amenities total budget £13,861.43 Allotments total budget £1,510.00 Churchyard total budget £1,510.00 Churchyard total budget £11,664.35 Planning total budget £10,210.00 Committee budgets total £128,354.78		
55.4	Precept: Following a general discussion regarding the level of precept to be set, Ms Barkham proposed that the precept remain as per 20/21 financial year, Mr Thompson seconded her proposal. Following a vote, with 8 members voting in favour of a 0% increase, 1 against and 2 abstaining, It was agreed that the precept be set at £126,015.13 which is a 0% increase or a reduction of 5p or 0.045% on a band D property at £110.71. The Committee budget total of £128,354.78 was agreed and it was further agreed that the Committee budget shortfall of £2339.65 be funded from general reserves.
